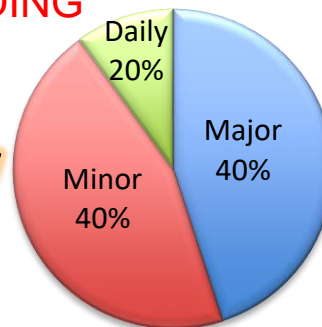
***¡Bienvenidos a la clase de español!***

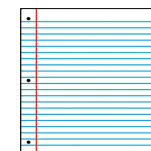

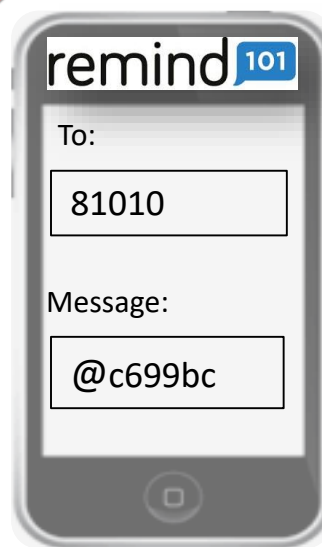
## Absent:
